

The Owlet Smart Sock 2 uses pulse oximetry to track your infant's heart rate and oxygen levels and is designed to notify you if something appears to be wrong.

## Parent Consent to Monitor

I	, confirm and give approval for my
child,	to wear the owlet baby monitor until 6

months old or older if the care giver and I see fit.

The monitor will not the place of the 15-minute checks. I understand that my child will still be monitored every 15 minutes physically. The Owlet is just another safety guard to help protect my child from SIDS.

I also give the provider permission to place the sock on my child if the provider believes my child is sick and needs to check his/her oxygen levels. (Especially on children in care with diagnosed asthma.)

I understand that red alarms may be false at times (no device is 100%) and it is up to me the parent to seek care once I am given notice that my child had a red alarm during care.

If the monitor causes any rashes/burn it will be addressed with the manufacture and the provider will not be held responsible in any way for the defective device.
